NEW LEDIG-ROWOHLT FELLOWSHIP CONDITIONS

Starting in 2020, there are several fellowship possibilities at the Chateau de Lavigny:

The Ledig-Rowohlt Full Grant Fellowship including full bed and board (dinner served by a chef and breakfast / lunch self-service, but provided). Only few Full Grant Fellowships are offered per year

The Ledig-Rowohlt Partial Grant Fellowship: includes full bed and board (dinner served by a chef and breakfast / lunch self-service, but provided) —a contribution of CHF 1'200 is requested and paid by the resident.

The Pro Helvetia Fellowship for Translators: provides translators, who have a confirmed project to translate a work by a Swiss living writer, and have signed a contract with a publishing house for this work, with a CHF 1'400.- stipend, as well as a fixed amount of CHF 300.- for travel expenses.
